


Learning at STV

Year 4 have had an exciting half term learning all about electricity! We have made circuits, experimented with conductors and insulators and even added switches. During History lessons we have learnt about the Romans, especially their army, and made shields.



Year 3 have loved learning about the Ancient Egyptians! We have recently made papyrus and decorated it using our knowledge of Egyptian Gods and hieroglyphics. In PE, we have really enjoyed working with Alice from the Yorkshire Cricket Board. Our maths skills have improved as we have been learning all about angles and especially right angles!



Year 6 have enjoyed designing and making bread with different toppings. We taste tested different breads and toppings, designed our own before making the bread dough. It was great fun!




Year 2 have been finding out about the work of Mary Anning, looking at fossils and how they are made and preserved and evidence of dinosaurs such as where they lived, what they ate and different types of dinosaurs. The dinosaur topic was also linked to our English where the children wrote a report based on their own dinosaur. In maths they have been working on the 2, 5 and 10 x tables and problem solving based on this. Science has been life processes and living things, looking at different categories of living things and how we know whether things are living or not.

Learning at STV

The HUB have focussed on choosing stronger words to suit the purpose of their writing about the jungle. To inspire us, we have used the famous painting 'Surprised!' by Henri Rousseau and listened to the sounds of the rainforest. We have also created our own jungle collages filled with fantastic creatures and beautiful plants.



Year 1 have been learning about Amy Johnson during our History lessons. In science we have been investigating different materials. We have been busy writing our own versions of Little Red Riding Hood too. One of the highlights of this half term was Internet Safety Day and Art week.



Year 5 have enjoyed Dance in PE. They showed off some great moves and learned about mirroring. These were made more enjoyable as we used the Just Dance videos for inspiration!



F1 and F2 have had great fun exploring all things that hide in the dark. We launched with our foundation stage 'dark day' where the children were able to explore shadow and began to read 'owl babies'. This took natural course and the children followed on their interests of learning all about nocturnal animals and their habitats, we made wonderful animal fact files. Some children took this further and were really keen to find out what was higher than the sky and began to explore space and planets!
